## Grade computer

Develop a $C$ program on the CS server to calculate your grade in CS 440. The program should prompt the user for the number of exams, the exam scores, the number of assignments, the assignment scores, and the final exam score. The final average should be displayed with one digit after the decimal place. An example run is shown below:

```
Number of Exams: 2
Exam 1 score: 85
Exam 2 score: 93
Number of Assignments: 3
Assignment 1 score: 90
Assignment 2 score: 70
Assignment 3 score: 85
Final score: 88
Average: 86.4
```

Your program must conform to the UNA CS Code Style Guide linked on the class web page. Your program must compile without any compiler warnings.
